

Each year Folk on the Rocks invites approximately 30 acts from around North America and overseas to perform on our stages on the shores of Long Lake, Yellowknife. Artists perform concerts and participate in several workshops (sing-arounds, jams or developmental workshops). All musical genres are considered.

Our Selection Committee considers every submission. When selecting artists we consider the strength of their performance and material, the overall variety of the Festival's artistic program and the artist's ability to provide original workshop ideas.

How to Apply: Submissions for Northern Performers is now open.

If you would like to be considered for our festival, please submit CD's and minimal printed materials (bio, contact sheet, press clippings, press kit) before March 4, 2011.
